APPLICATIONS:

Hyong Mun presented an application for a new deck and the replacement of four (4) doors in the rear at **604 Langdon Street**. The proposed deck replaces an existing the deck; the new deck shall be the same size as the deck previously located at this location. The spindles will be square, black metal or iron. The railing will be wood. The railing will be at least three (3) feet in height. The two (2) doors that lead onto the deck will be replaced. The current doors have two (2) window panes and the new doors will have six (6) window panes; the two (2) doors below the deck will not have windows.

Mary Anderson made a motion to approve the proposed deck based on the information presented, Matt Asselmeier seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
