

ADA Committee

A meeting of the ADA Committee was called to order at 10:03 A.M., on August 24, 2015, at Alton City Hall, 101 E. Third Street, Alton, Illinois.

Introductions occurred.

Sue Wuellner-Derr made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2015, meeting, seconded by Margaret Renken. Motion passed unanimously.

The Committee reviewed the proposed Transition Plan. Discussion occurred regarding the definition of "park facilities." Priority would be given to buildings. Sue Wuellner-Derr made a motion to recommend approval of the proposed Transition Plan, second by Mary Boulds. Motion passed unanimously.

The 30 day public comment period would run from September 9th until October 8th, with open houses occurring at IMPACT on September 24th and City Hall on October 1st. The public hearing before the City Council is scheduled for October 28th. If everything goes according to schedule, the City Council could approve the Transition Plan on November 10th. Margaret Renken made a motion to approve the comment period, open houses dates, and public hearing date, seconded by Wendy Settles. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion occurred regarding increasing attendance at open houses and increasing comments from the public. The notice is placed in the newspaper and on various websites. People are given numerous opportunities to comment on the Transition Plan.

There were no comments from the public or other business from Committee members.

Sue Wuellner-Derr made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mary Boulds. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 10:10 A.M.
